



Returning to Ireland Documents Checklist

To make returning easier, we have put together a handy list of essential documents to prepare and bring with you. In addition to hard copies, be sure to save electronic copies to your email or in the cloud so you can access important documents from anywhere.

Accommodation

- Landlord references
- Property and mortgage documents (as relevant)
- Rental agreement, lease, and/or termination

Child Dependants

- Passport(s)
- Birth certificate(s)
- Education and medical records
- Consent from other guardians (as relevant)

Contacts

- Emergency contact details / details of next of kin

Driving and Insurance

- Driving licence and letter from issuing authority ([learn more](#))
- Evidence of foreign driving record/no claims bonus

Employment

- Updated CV
- Employer references
- Proof of foreign education and/or qualifications
- Foreign social insurance number and records
- Self-employment: closure of business/termination of self-employment

Finance

- Bank cards and details (proof of closure as relevant)
- Recent bank, investment statements (at least 6-12 months)
- Personal credit history documents
- Foreign tax records (including superannuation and pension)
- Details of any social welfare payments/benefits from abroad, including details of closed claims

Health

- Prescription(s)
- Medical records
- Immunisation and vaccine records
- Medical insurance that will cover you upon arrival (could be travel insurance)

Identification

- Irish passport (and any other passport you may hold)
- Birth certificate
- Secondary form of ID (e.g. passport card)
- PPS Number

Marital Status

- Marriage / divorce certificates as relevant

Non-Irish Family

- Passport(s)
- Relevant visa permission(s) and supporting documents
- Comprehensive travel insurance
